Sean retired from the Yonkers Police Department in 2023 and has been working at the family business since his retirement. Sean and his family are the proud owners and operators of J.C. Fogarty's in Bronxville, NY.

The Society is proud to also recognize **The Detective Barney Ferguson Emerald Legacy Fund** as this year's "Distinguished Service Award" recipient. The Detective Barney Ferguson Legacy Fund was founded in 2015 by James Bernard Ferguson, Jr. Esq., the son of the late Det. J. Barney Ferguson. 


